Project aim:

Due to sickness and need for emergency surgery project 2 has not progressed in the last month

Project 1

To improve information availability and sharing for children with epilepsy by improving electronically held information and developing epilepsy passports. As predicted the IT improvements are taking time to happen, but the team have been working on the introduction of the epilepsy passport. See Driver diagram.

Project 2

By May 2020 70% of Paediatric requests for EEG will have had the test and report within 8 weeks of presenting to medical services with a seizure. *See attached driver diagram.*

Through the meetings of the EQIP team we have now added an EEG project so we now have two main projects; this reflects the fact that we have a member of the neurophysiology team as part of our group and an enthusiastic and dedicated neurophysiology team. This is an ambitious project in EEG and we may just choose a part of it to present in May.

Planned tests:

Project 1

To complete a RCPCH epilepsy passport for 5 children in York and Scarborough over the next month.

Project 2

a) To test emailing EEG neurophysiology for all week from York. To request two secretaries test for one week.

requests direct to requests in one Scarborough and

b) To collect written feedback on the currently used letter sent to all families coming for EEG and the information booklet for children. To ask if they families want written information through the post or other forms of communication (phone calls, text, emails)

Results:

Project 1

Information from the service improvement project, feedback from two parents and feedback from specialist epilepsy nurses used to create an adapted passport, permission granted from RCPCH to adapt their passport. This will now be used with 10 families and feedback collected

IT have created an alert for emergency seizure management plans – this feels a fantastic step forward, have now uploaded 50% of individualized emergency seizure plans.
