Project aim:

Achieve a full quality and interpretable routine EEG recording in 95% of all paediatric patients referred within 4 weeks from referral by May 2020'.

Planned tests:

1. Additional leaflet to go in patient leaflet with links to online resources – Evelina video, plus our adult learning disability leaflet and video to help prepare patients coming for the test

Results:

1. Too soon to get feedback from patients about additional resource and whether they have accessed
2. Questionnaires continue to trickle in with patients wanting more info and phone call before they come.

Challenges Successes:

1. Still struggling to make the phone calls to patients (mainly due to time) so have started sending out an addendum to our patient leaflet (as above).
2. Did have a successful patient who came for a repeat EEG after struggling on the first occasion. 11 year old with severe autism. I had discussed 'ways forward' with mum and we had agreed to try melatonin for a sleep and to watch on-line video which they did. EEG very successful. Mums words 'this is 100% better than last time, thank you so much'
