### Assessment of mental health issues (KPI 6)

% of CYP with epilepsy where there is documented evidence that they have been asked about mental health either through clinical screening, or a questionnaire/measure

Annually; annual report, TBH report, NHSE data pack

### Mental health support (KPI 7)

% of CYP with epilepsy and a mental health problem who have evidence of mental health support

### Epilepsy surgery referral (KPI 3b)

% of ongoing CYP meeting defined Children's Epilepsy Surgery Service (CESS) referral criteria with evidence of CESS referral
